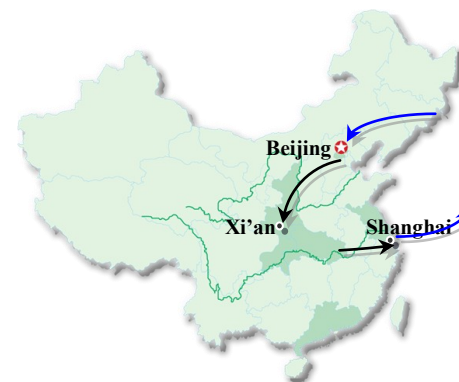

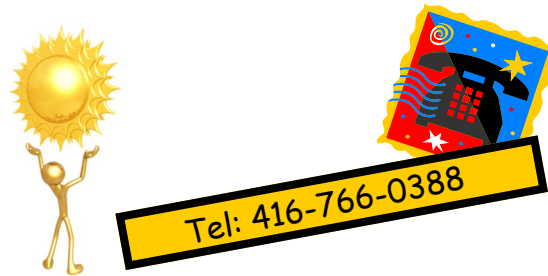


## TRAVEL COMMITTEE
